**Copy of Burning Yard Waste Ordinance**

The burning of yard waste is prohibited in the Plantation Point Community. Yard waste is defined as vegetative debris such as grass clippings, brush, leaves, tree limbs, palm fronds, etc., that are a result of yard maintenance. Nassau County ordinances eliminate the possibility that a Plantation Point Homeowner can meet the burning yard waste criteria...

- A cover is required to keep sparks from flying out and starting new fires.
- **Smoke cannot become a hazard or nuisance to neighbors or surrounding structures.**
- The required setbacks must be met in order to burn yard waste:
  - 50 feet from paved community roads;
  - 25 feet from your house;
  - **150 feet from other occupied buildings or houses.**
- Burn area must be cleared to bare soil to prevent the fire from spreading.

**NOTE: It is illegal to burn household garbage including paper products, treated lumber, plastics, rubber materials, tires, pesticides, paints and aerosol containers.**
